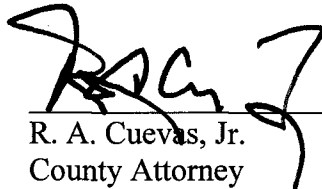

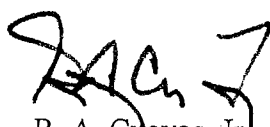

RESOLUTION DIRECTING MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO PREPARE A CONTINGENCY PLAN IN THE EVENT OF ABOLISHMENT OF A MUNICIPALITY AND TO SUBMIT SUCH PLAN TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR ITS REVIEW

WHEREAS, the Home Rule Charter authorizes municipal electors pursuant to Article 6 Section 6.03 to abolish their own municipalities; and

WHEREAS, recent enactments by the Florida Legislature have placed certain taxing constraints on local governments which may increase the risk that certain municipalities will consider abolishment; and

WHEREAS, such action may have an impact on the County as a whole,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the Board hereby directs the Mayor or his designee to develop a contingency plan in the event that a municipality exercises its right to abolish itself and submit the plan to the Board of County Commissioners within _____ days of the effective date of this resolution.
