

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE APRIL 18-20, 2008 SPRINGS RIVER FESTIVAL SPONSORED BY SPRINGS RIVER FESTIVAL, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,266.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE DISTRICT 6 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the Springs River Festival, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park Recreation Department for the Springs River Festival in an amount not to exceed \$4,266.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and



The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization the Springs River Festival, Inc. for the "Springs River Festival" event held on April 18-20, 2007.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$4,266 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for use of a large showmobile. This event will be funded from the District 6 in-kind reserve fund.
