WE EVEN HAVE TWO MIAMIANS WHO WON SILVER MEDALS IN THE RECENT WINTER OLYMPICS!

BOBSLEDDER LAURYN WILLIAMS WAS A TRACK STAR AT UM AND SHORT TRACK SPEED SKATER EDDY ALVAREZ IS A MIAMI NATIVE, AND A FELLOW COLUMBUS EXPLORER.

THEY REPRESENTED OUR COMMUNITY AND OUR COUNTRY WITH GREAT PRIDE!

WE WANT MORE CHILDREN FROM MIAMI TO GROW UP WITH THE OPPORTUNITY TO COMPETE IN THE OLYMPICS, IN THE NFL OR NBA, AND YES, IN THE MLS.

WHEN YOU VISIT OUR NEIGHBORHOODS AND SEE GIRLS AND BOYS PLAYING SOCCER, WHO KNOWS, MAYBE THERE IS A WORLD CUP STAR IN THE MAKING.

THIS IS WHY WE CONTINUE NEGOTIATIONS WITH DAVID BECKHAM ON FINDING A HOME FOR HIS MLS FRANCHISE.

AND LET ME ADD - DAVID BECKHAM COULD HAVE GONE ANYWHERE - BUT HE CAME HERE.

TAKE, FOR EXAMPLE, THIRTY-THREE YEAR OLD AFRICAN-AMERICAN PLAYWRIGHT TARELL MCCRANEY.

TARELL GOT HIS INTRODUCTION TO THE ARTS IN LIBERTY CITY AT THE COUNTY'S AFRICAN HERITAGE CULTURAL ARTS CENTER.

AFTER STUDYING AT NEW WORLD SCHOOL OF THE ARTS,
DEPAUL UNIVERSITY, YALE, AND RECEIVING A
MACARTHUR GENIUS GRANT...

TARELL'S PLAYS HAVE BEEN PERFORMED IN ENGLAND, MIAMI, AND HE'S NOW IN NEW YORK FOR HIS LATEST PLAY.

BEST OF ALL, TARELL IS COMING BACK TO MIAMI TO HELP REVIVE REGIONAL THEATER AT THE COCONUT GROVE PLAYHOUSE...

HELPING US BREATHE NEW LIFE TO THAT STAGE THAT HAS BEEN SILENT FOR SO LONG.

TARELL IS THE KIND OF TALENT THAT OUR NEIGHBORHOOD ARTS CENTERS CAN PRODUCE...

AND THESE ARE THE KINDS OF OPPORTUNITIES WE WANT TO GIVE EVERY CHILD IN MIAMI-DADE.

THESE OPPORTUNITIES WILL REQUIRE OUR INVESTMENT.

COMMISSIONERS, WE NEED TO WORK TOGETHER ON THIS EFFORT.

WHERE THE ARTS, LIBRARIES, AND PARKS CAN ALL COME TOGETHER TO PROVIDE GATHERING PLACES THAT ENGAGE OUR YOUTH.

THIS COMING MAY, WE'LL HOST THE "E-MERGE AMERICAS" CONFERENCE, A GATHERING OF THE BRIGHTEST LEADING-EDGE TECH THINKERS AND INNOVATORS.

AS PART OF "E-MERGE," I HAVE INVITED MAYORS FROM THROUGHOUT THE WORLD TO MEET FOR THE MAYORAL INNOVATION SUMMIT...

WITH THE GOAL OF SHARING WAYS ON HOW TO TRANSFORM OUR COMMUNITIES INTO "SMARTER CITIES" THROUGH TECHNOLOGY.

WE'RE TAKING ADVANTAGE OF TECHNOLOGY IN ALL OUR FUNCTIONS TO DO THINGS SMARTER, BETTER, FASTER, AND CHEAPER!

ONE AREA WHERE WE'RE DOING THIS IS THE WAY WE PRESENT OURSELVES IN THE DIGITAL WORLD. OUR COUNTY'S WEBSITE HAD 22 MILLION HITS LAST YEAR.

WE'RE ALSO MOVING MANY OF OUR FUNCTIONS ON-LINE AND TO MOBILE APPS.

WE ARE EXTENDING THIS THINKING TO LAUNCH A "ONE-STOP SITE" THAT PRESENTS ONE ACCESS POINT WITH KEY INFORMATION FOR THOSE WHO WANT TO OPEN BUSINESSES HERE.

WE NEED TO UNDERSTAND THAT OUR ECONOMIES ARE ALL CONNECTED. THE WORLD SEES US AS ONE MIAMI, AND IT'S TIME WE SEE OURSELVES THE SAME WAY.

WE NEED TO REPLACE COMPETITION, WITH COOPERATION.
NEIGHBORING CITIES NEED TO COMPLEMENT ONE
ANOTHER.

IMAGINE BEING ABLE TO HARNESS THE ECONOMIC ENERGY OF ONE CONNECTED URBAN CORE -

BRICKELL, DOWNTOWN, MID-TOWN, AND SOUTH BEACH.

THIS IS WHY WE ARE WORKING TO MAKE BAY LINK A REALITY.

WITH OUR STATE PARTNERS, AND THROUGH A COLLABORATIVE EFFORT BETWEEN THE MAYORS OF MIAMI AND MIAMI BEACH...

THE BLUEPRINT FOR STARTING WORK ON BAY LINK...

AND START TO BRING MIAMI AND MIAMI BEACH CLOSER TOGETHER.

IT'S NOT JUST ABOUT BETTER MOBILITY AND EASING TRAFFIC...

THINK ABOUT LIVING ON THE BEACH AND WORKING DOWNTOWN, OR VICE VERSA, AND BEING ABLE TO GET AROUND, ALL ON PUBLIC TRANSIT.

AND WHILE WE WILL REACH OUT TO OUR PARTNERS AT THE FEDERAL AND STATE LEVEL...

I'VE OFTEN JOKED THAT THE TWO MAN MADE THINGS YOU CAN SEE FROM OUTER SPACE ARE THE GREAT WALL OF CHINA AND THE MIAMI-DADE / BROWARD COUNTY LINE.

WELL, NO LONGER.

JUST TWO WEEKS AGO I HAD THE MAYORS FROM BROWARD AND PALM BEACH IN MY OFFICE FOR A TRI-COUNTY MEETING.

WE'RE WORKING TOGETHER IN UNPRECEDENTED WAYS ON ISSUES OF SUSTAINABILITY, TRANSIT, AND COMMERCE, BECAUSE OUR FUTURES ARE INTERTWINED.

AND WE ARE PLANNING ON VISITING OUR PARTNERS IN TALLAHASSEE AS ONE REGION THAT SHARES COMMON GOALS.

IN THIS SPIRIT OF CONNECTIVITY, OUR COMMUNITY IS WELL POSITIONED TO COMPETE IN THE NEW ECONOMY.
