

JUNETEENTH 2024

Juneteenth is named after the historic date of June 19, 1865, when U.S. General Gordon Granger announced the freedom of enslaved individuals in Galveston, Texas, nearly two-anda-half years after President Abraham Lincoln signed the Emancipation Proclamation in 1863. Juneteenth marks the date when more than 250,000 African Americans learned they were freed from slavery. Also known as the United States' Second Independence Day, the date was officially designated a federal holiday in June 2021. Juneteenth is a time to revere Black ancestors, reflect on the country's history and collectively celebrate Black freedom.
