

RESOLUTION NO. R-737-92

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SISTER CITY PROGRAM
BETWEEN METROPOLITAN DADE COUNTY AND THE
CABILDO OF TENERIFE, CANARY ISLANDS, SPAIN

WHEREAS, representatives of Metropolitan Dade County and the Cabildo of Tenerife, Canary Islands, Spain, met and have expressed a desire to establish a Sister City Program between the two governments and their people; and

WHEREAS, Dade County desires to establish such a program in order to foster enhanced relationships with the Cabildo of Tenerife, Canary Islands, Spain,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board, on behalf of the citizens of Metropolitan Dade County, Florida, hereby establishes a Sister City Program with the government and citizens of the Cabildo of Tenerife, Canary Islands, Spain.

Section 2. A committee shall be appointed to establish the Sister City Program and carry out the objectives of fostering enhanced economic and cultural relations between the two governments and their people.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner

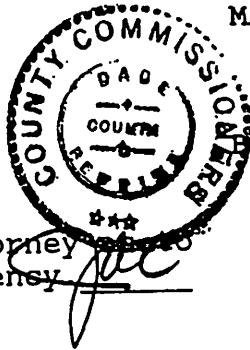
Mary Collins, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Alexander Penelas, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
