RESOLUTION NO. R-814-89

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SISTER CITY PROGRAM  
BETWEEN METROPOLITAN DADE COUNTY AND  
TAIPEI COUNTY, TAIWAN, REPUBLIC OF CHINA

WHEREAS, representatives of Metropolitan Dade County and Taipei County, Taiwan, Republic of China, met and have expressed a desire to establish a Sister City Program between the two governments and their people; and

WHEREAS, Dade County desires to establish such a Program in order to foster enhanced relationships with Taipei County, Taiwan, Republic of China,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board, on behalf of the citizens of Metropolitan Dade County, Florida, hereby establishes a Sister City Program with the government and citizens of Taipei County, Taiwan, Republic of China.

Section 2. A committee be appointed to establish the Sister City Program and carry out the objectives of fostering enhanced economic and social relationships between the two (2) governments and their people.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner

Stephen P. Clark, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Larry Hawkins
