

RESOLUTION NO. R-1125-90

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SISTER CITY PROGRAM
BETWEEN METROPOLITAN DADE COUNTY AND
VERACRUZ, MEXICO

WHEREAS, representatives of Metropolitan Dade County and Veracruz, Mexico, met and have expressed a desire to establish a Sister City Program between the two governments and their people; and

WHEREAS, Dade County desires to establish such a program in order to foster enhanced relationships with Veracruz, Mexico,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board, on behalf of the citizens of Metropolitan Dade County, Florida, hereby establishes a Sister City Program with the government and citizens of Veracruz, Mexico.

Section 2. A committee shall be appointed to establish the Sister City Program and carry out the objectives of fostering enhanced economic and social relations between the two governments and their people.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Mayor Stephen P. Clark, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Charles Dusseau, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

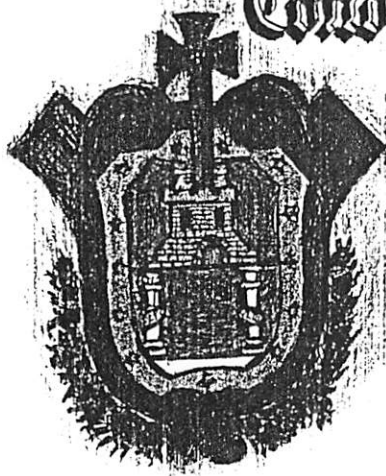
