Considerando che il Consiglio dei commissari della Contea di Miami-Dade, Florida, in data 8 luglio 2021, ha approvato una risoluzione che esprime il desiderio di stabilire un Patto di Amicizia tra la Contea di Miami-Dade e la Città di Viareggio;

considerando che la Giunta comunale di Viareggio, in data 4 ottobre 2021, ha deliberato la volontà di sottoscrivere un Patto di Amicizia tra la Città di Viareggio e la Contea di Miami-Dade;

considerando che anche il sindaco della Contea di Miami-Dade, in Florida, e il sindaco della Città di Viareggio, Italia, desiderano stabilire una relazione di amicizia tra i rispettivi Enti;

considerando che sia la Contea di Miami-Dade che la Città di Viareggio vogliono collaborare per ampliare ulteriormente le opportunità commerciali, turistiche, culturali, economiche ed educative;

considerando che entrambe le Comunità basano la propria economia sul commercio e sul turismo e soddisfano le linee guida stabilite dalla Contea di Miami-Dade per entrare in relazione con un Patto di Amicizia

Tutto ciò premesso, si stabilisce che il presidente della contea di Miami-Dade, il sindaco della contea di Miami-Dade, in Florida, e il sindaco della Città di Viareggio, in Italia, convengono reciprocamente di:

- A) stabilire un Patto di Amicizia tra la Contea di Miami-Dade, Florida, e la Città di Viareggio, Italia
- B) intraprendere programmi che amplino le opportunità economiche, culturali ed educative
- C) impegnarsi in un programma di scambio di buone pratiche tra i due governi
- D) intraprendere missioni commerciali e culturali nelle rispettive Comunità

SISTER CITIES AGREEMENT BETWEEN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA AND VIAREGGIO CITY, ITALY

Whereas, the board of County Commissioners of Miami-Dade County, Florida, on July 8, 2021, passed a resolution expressing a desire to establish a sister cities relationship between Miami-Dade County and the Viareggio City; and

Whereas, the Viareggio City council on October 4, 2021, passed a resolution recommending a Sister Cities affiliation between Comune di Viareggio and Miami-Dade County; and

Whereas, the Mayor of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and the Mayor of the Viareggio City, Italy, also desire to enter into a Sister Cities affiliation; and

Whereas, both Miami-Dade County and the Viareggio City want to cooperate in order to further expand trade, tourism, cultural, economic and educational opportunities; and

Whereas, both communities base their economy on trade and tourism, and meet the guidelines established by Miami-Dade County to enter into a Sister Cities relationship.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Mayor of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and the Mayor of the Viareggio City, Italy hereby mutually agree to:

A) establish a Sister Cities relationship between Miami-Dade County, Florida and the Viareggio City, Italy

B) undertake programs that expand economic, cultural and educational opportunities

C) engage in an exchange program of best practices between the two governments

D) undertake trade and cultural missions to each Community

In witness thereof we have affixed our signatures to this sister cities agreement on this date of October 11, 2021

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE AND, TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE, EXECUTE A SISTER CITY AGREEMENT WITH VIAREGGIO, ITALY; AND DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PROVIDE A REPORT TO THIS BOARD

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County, Florida (the "County") has long established affiliations and partnerships with other cities throughout the world in the form of cooperative relationships through which cultural, educational, business, and technical exchanges take place; and

WHEREAS, Sister Cities International is an international nonprofit organization created during President Dwight D. Eisenhower's 1956 White House summit on citizen diplomacy to encourage and foster bonds between people from different communities around the world; and

WHEREAS, Sister Cities International recommends formalizing a sister cities relationship through execution of a memorandum of understanding between the two communities; and

WHEREAS, in 1981, the Miami-Dade Sister Cities Program (the "Program") was founded by the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board"); and

WHEREAS, the Program has established sister cities relationships with approximately 25 cities throughout the world, developing innovative projects, furthering international cooperation and understanding between the County and our respective sister cities, and helping promote the County's position as the Gateway to the Americas; and

WHEREAS, in light of the great benefits brought by sister cities relationships, the County would like to direct the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to negotiate, and to the extent possible, execute a Sister City Agreement with Viareggio, Italy,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to negotiate, and to the extent possible, execute a Sister City Agreement with Viareggio, Italy.

Section 2. Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to provide a report to this Board within 60 days of the effective date of this resolution regarding the status of the negotiation and execution of the agreement in Section 1 and place the completed report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Chairman Jose "Pepe" Diaz. It was offered by Commissioner , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
