Community Council <i>(Nonpartisan)</i>	<i>No earlier than the 72nd day and no later than noon on the 70th day prior to the date of the election at which he or she is a candidate [Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinances, Part III, Chapter 20, Article IV, Section 20-43(A)(4)]</i>	8:00 am, Monday, June 8, 2020 * through Noon, Tuesday, June 9, 2020
South Dade Soil and Water Conservation District <i>(Nonpartisan)</i>	<i>Between noon of the 71st day prior to the primary election and noon of the 67th day prior to the date of the primary election [F.S. 99.061(3)]</i>	Noon, Monday, June 8, 2020 through Noon, Friday, June 12, 2020
Community Development District <i>(Nonpartisan)</i>	<i>Between noon of the 71st day prior to the primary election and noon of the 67th day prior to the date of the primary election [F.S. 99.061(3)]</i>	Noon, Monday, June 8, 2020 through Noon, Friday, June 12, 2020
