Section 3. The Charter Review Task Force shall be staffed by the County Mayor or the County Mayor's Designee, the County Attorney, and County Clerk and all expenses shall be reimbursed from general funds subject to the requirements of State Law.

Section 4. The Charter Review Task Force shall review the Home Rule Charter of Miami-Dade County in its entirety and shall prepare and submit to this board written recommendations setting forth any proposed amendments or revisions to the Charter. In conducting its review, the Task Force should:

- a. Study the Final Report of the last Charter Review Task force;
- b. Invite knowledgeable members of the community to appear and
- c. make recommendations;
- d. Conduct public hearings at various stages in the review process;
- e. [

Section 5. The Board hereby expresses its intent to place all matters approved by a

[] vote of the membership of the Charter Review Task Force on the []
election ballot in 2012.

Section 6. All proceedings of the Charter Review Task Force shall be conducted in accordance with the Government in the Sunshine Law (Sec. 286.011 Fla. Stats.) and the Citizens' Bill of Rights of the Miami-Dade County Home Rule Charter. The Task Force shall be deemed an "agency" for the purposes of the Public Records Law (Sec. 119 Fla. Stats.).

Section 7. The Charter Review Task Force shall submit its written recommendations to this Board within [] days of the effective date of this resolution.

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Section 8. The Charter Review Task Force created pursuant to this resolution shall sunset and dissolve on the 320th day from the effective date of this resolution.
