

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 47TH STREET FROM
SW 122ND AVENUE TO SW 127TH AVENUE AS “TONY ‘EL
BOY’ ACOSTA BOULEVARD”

WHEREAS, Antonio Gabriel Acosta was born in Miami, Florida, on July 30, 1993 to Cuban immigrant parents, the youngest of four siblings; and

WHEREAS, Tony, as he was known by his classmates, attended Belen Jesuit School starting in the sixth grade and through the years he was always at the top of the class; and

WHEREAS, he was very involved with community service through his school’s Key Club, often tutoring children; and

WHEREAS, Tony Acosta died in a tragic car accident on October 1st, 2010; and

WHEREAS, he will be remembered as being a compassionate, loving and caring person; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor Tony Acosta with this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, SW 47th Street from SW 122nd Avenue to SW 127th Avenue is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 10,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates SW 47th Street from SW 122nd Avenue to SW 127th Avenue as “Tony ‘El Boy’ Acosta Boulevard”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the

Public Works Department, the Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
