ORDINANCE RELATING TO ZONING; PROVIDING FOR MOVIE AND TELEVISION STUDIOS IN BU-2 (SPECIAL (INDUSTRIAL BUSINESS DISTRICT), IU-1 MANUFACTURING DISTRICT), AND IU-2 (INDUSTRIAL, DISTRICT); MANUFACTURING AMENDING SECTIONS 33-253, 33-259, AND 33-262 OF THE CODE OF **MIAMI-DADE** COUNTY, FLORIDA; **PROVIDING** SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 33-253 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:¹

Sec. 33-253. U

Uses permitted.

No land, body of water and/or structure shall be used or permitted to be used, and no structure shall be hereafter erected, constructed, reconstructed, moved, occupied or maintained for any purpose in any BU-2 District except for one (1) or more of the following uses:

- >>(5.1) Movie and television studios with indoor sound stages/studios.
- (5.2) Movie and television studios with outdoor lots/backlots after public hearing.<<

Words stricken through and/or [[double bracketed]] shall be deleted. Words underscored and/or >>double arrowed<< constitute the amendment proposed. Remaining provisions are now in effect and remain unchanged.

<u>Section 2.</u> Section 33-259 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 33-259.

Uses permitted.

No land, body of water or structure shall be used or permitted to be used and no structure shall be erected, constructed, moved or reconstructed, structurally altered, or maintained, which is designed, arranged or intended to be used or occupied for any purpose, unless otherwise provided herein, in IU-1 District, excepting for one (1) or more of the following:

[[(53) Motion picture production studios.]]

- >>(53) Movie and television studios with indoor sound stages/studios.
- (53.1) Movie and television studios with outdoor lots/backlots after public hearing.<<

Section 3. Section 33-262 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 33-262.

Uses permitted.

No land, body of water or structure shall be used or permitted to be used and no structure shall be hereafter constructed, reconstructed or structurally altered, maintained or moved in any IU-2 District, which is designed, arranged or intended to be used for any purpose, unless otherwise provided herein, except for one (1) of the following uses:

>>(2.5) Movie and television studios with indoor sound stages/studios and outdoor lots/backlots.<<

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Section 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance

is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 5. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby

ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall become and

be made a part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this ordinance may

be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be

changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.

Section 6. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of

enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an

override by this Board.
