(2) Definitions. The following definitions shall apply in this section

8. Contract means an agreement for the purchase of goods or services, including professional services. Professional services as used in this section includes but is not limited to accounting, legal, health care, consulting and management services. Contract does not mean>>:<< an agreement to purchase, lease, or rent real property; a grant, license, permit, franchise or a concession; an agreement to acquire professional architectural, engineering, landscape architectural or land surveying and mapping services>> of two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) or less<<; or a contract for construction or construction management services>> of two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) or less<<.

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance

is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 3. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is

hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall

become and be made part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this

ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word

"ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of

enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an

override by this Board.
