RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR DESIGNEE TO PREPARE A REPORT WITHIN SIXTY DAYS REGARDING NECESSARY STEPS TO INCREASE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE COUNTY'S TAXICAB INSPECTION PROCESS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 31 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida (the "Code"), the County regulates for-hire vehicles including, but not limited to, taxicabs; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 31 of the Code requires that taxicabs comply with numerous vehicle standards relating to, among other things, the appearance of the vehicle; and

WHEREAS, to ensure that the standards are complied with, the Code requires periodic inspections of all taxicabs; and

WHEREAS, the County has one for-hire inspection station located at 2615 NW 10^{th} Avenue in Miami; and

WHEREAS, this inspection station has seven (7) employees including five (5) vehicle inspectors; and

WHEREAS, a substantial number of complaints have been received regarding the condition of vehicles which have been inspected by the County; and

WHEREAS, the Commission believes that it is in the best interest of the County for the administration to evaluate ways in which to improve the effectiveness of the taxicab inspection process,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the Mayor or designee is directed to evaluate ways in which to improve the effectiveness of the taxicab inspection process.
