RESOLUTION COMMENDING CVS CAREMARK FOR COMMITMENT TO STOP SALE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS WITHIN STORES AND URGING OTHER RETAILERS TO CONSIDER MAKING A SIMILAR COMMITMENT

WHEREAS, the dangers of tobacco use are well studied and widely publicized; and

WHEREAS, cigarette smoking accounts for approximately 430,000 deaths annually in the United States; and

WHEREAS, cigarette smoking doubles a person's risk of coronary heart disease and stroke and increases the risk of developing lung cancer; and

WHEREAS, cigarette smoking also causes coronary heart disease, cancer of the esophagus, larynx, and oral cavity, as well as stomach, kidney, and pancreatic cancer; and

WHEREAS, cigarette smoking has been linked to infertility, low birth weight, stillbirth and sudden infant death syndrome; and

WHEREAS, the American Pharmacists' Association, National Community Pharmacists' Association, and the American Academy of Pediatrics have all expressed support for restricting the sale of tobacco products; and

WHEREAS, CVS Caremark recently announced it would stop selling tobacco products in its more than 7,600 CVS stores, despite the profits made from such sales; and

WHEREAS, other retail establishments should consider following CVS Caremark's example and stop selling tobacco products,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

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Section 1. Commends CVS Caremark's commitment to stop selling tobacco products in its more than 7,600 stores, and urges other retailers to consider making a similar commitment.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit this Resolution to Larry J. Merlo, CEO of CVS Caremark, and the Board of Directors of CVS Caremark.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan. It was offered by Commissioner , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
