ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 11C OF THE MIAMIDADE COUNTY CODE, AMENDING SECTION 11C-6 CREATING AN EXEMPTION FOR ACCESSORY STORAGE STRUCTURES INCIDENTAL TO SINGLE FAMILY HOMES AND DUPLEXES, PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That Chapter 11C of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is amended as follows:<sup>1</sup>

## **CHAPTER 11C**

## DEVELOPMENT WITHIN FLOOD HAZARD DISTRICTS

Sec. 11C-6. Accessory buildings.

Nothing herein shall be construed to exclude accessory buildings from the provisions of this chapter >> except as provided in this section <<.

>>(a) Pre-manufactured sheds and wood sheds with a gross area less than 720 square feet used solely for storage, incidental to a single-family or duplex use shall be exempt from the provisions of this chapter.<<

Words stricken through and/or [[double bracketed]] shall be deleted. Words underscored and/or >>double arrowed<< constitute the amendment proposed. The remaining provisions are now in effect and remain unchanged.

**Section 2.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance

is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 3. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby

ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall become and

be made a part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this ordinance may

be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be

changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of

enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an

override by this Board.
