RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 110TH AVENUE FROM SW 32ND STREET TO SW 40TH STREET AS "EUCARIO BERMUDEZ WAY" BY A THREE-FIFTHS VOTE OF BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT

WHEREAS, Eucario Bermudez, born in Temio, Colombia, was a founder of Colombian radio in Miami; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bermudez began working for WSUA-AM Miami "Radio Caracol 1260 AM" when the station launched in 1994; and

WHEREAS, during his over 25 year career with Radio Caracol, Mr. Bermudez emerged as one of Miami's most respected journalists; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bermudez is the recipient of many awards, including the prestigious Premios Onda Award from Spain; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bermudez served as President of the Columbian American Chamber of Commerce, founded the Association of Colombian News Outlets and Journalists in the United States, the Colombian American Association, and the first ever Colombian Political Action Committee, COLPAC; and

WHEREAS, SW 110th Avenue from SW 32nd Street to SW 40th Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor Eucario Bermudez by codesignating SW 110th Avenue from SW 32nd Street to SW 40th Street as "Eucario Bermudez Way;" and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 10; and

WHEREAS, Rule 9.02(d) of the Board's Rules of Procedure provides that the Commission may by a three-fifths vote of Board members present name a County road, facility or property after a living individual who has not served as an elected official within the past five years and who "has made a direct, significant lifetime contribution to this community,"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this resolution and the Board finds that Eucario Bermudez has made direct, significant lifetime contributions to this community pursuant to Rule 9.02(d).

Section 2. Having considered this matter at a public hearing and by a three-fifths vote of Board members present, the Board codesignates SW 110th Avenue from SW 32nd Street to SW 40th Street as "Eucario Bermudez Way".

Section 3. The Board directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
