**WHEREAS**, Pablo Roberto Castro was born on November 1, 1966 in Massachusetts, and moved to Miami with his family in 1973; and

SW 22ND STREET TO SW 26TH STREET AS "SFC PABLO

ROBERTO CASTRO AVENUE"

WHEREAS, he graduated from Miami's Coral Park Senior High School, where he was a member of the school's Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC) program; and

WHEREAS, he first enlisted in the United States Army through his ROTC program in 1984 as an Aircraft Crewman and then re-enlisted in 1986 as an Infantryman; and

WHEREAS, he remained in active service, and served at Fort Bragg, Fort Benning, Eglin Air Force Base, and the United States Southern Command (SOUTHCOM); and

WHEREAS, he was assigned as a Rifle Platoon Sergeant and Senior Intelligence Sergeant in June of 2005; and

WHEREAS, he was deployed overseas in April of 2007 as part of Operation Iraqi Freedom; and

WHEREAS, he admirably served this nation for approximately twenty years and earned various commendations including, but not limited to, the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal with Two Oak Leaf Clusters, Joint Service Achievement Medal, Army Achievement Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Iraqi Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Humanitarian Service Medal, and two Overseas Service Ribbons; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant First Class (SFC) Castro tragically lost his life in 2008 due to an accident with his parachute during an aerial show; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Pablo Roberto Castro by codesignating S.W. 129<sup>th</sup> Avenue from S.W. 22<sup>nd</sup> Street to S.W. 26<sup>th</sup> Street as "SFC Pablo Roberto Castro Avenue;" and

**WHEREAS**, S.W. 129<sup>th</sup> Avenue from S.W. 22<sup>nd</sup> Street to S.W. 26<sup>th</sup> Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, Rule 9.02 of the Board's Rules of Procedure provides that resolutions regarding proposed codesignations of Miami-Dade County roads shall be sponsored by the district commissioner where the road is located; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 11,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates S.W. 129<sup>th</sup> Avenue from S.W. 22<sup>nd</sup> Street to S.W. 26<sup>th</sup> Street as "SFC Pablo Roberto Castro Avenue."

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.
