## **Executive Summary**

This item requests approval from the Board of County Commissioners (Board) to extend the Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with HNTB Corporation (HNTB) for Construction, Engineering, and Inspection Services (CEI) for the South Corridor Rapid Transit Project (Project) by 339 calendars days. This additional time is in line with the proposed time extension of the construction contract, enabling HNTB to oversee the owner-requested technology change in the signal system (i.e., traffic controllers) and the deployment of the fare collection system. There is no cost associated with this supplemental agreement.

# Recommendation

This item recommends approval of the attached Supplemental Agreement No. 3 with HNTB (Contract No CIP155-DTPW19-CEI) and Miami-Dade County (County) for CEI Services for the South Corridor Rapid Transit Project, extending the PSA by 339 calendar days. This is a non-compensable time extension, aligning the Project schedule with that of the construction contract.

#### Scone

The Project extends from SW 344 Street to the Dadeland South Station within Districts 7, 8, and 9, represented by Commissioners Raquel A. Regalado, Danielle Cohen Higgins, and Kionne L. McGhee, respectively. However, the South Dade TransitWay has a countywide impact as it promotes connectivity to the entirety of the transit system.

## **Delegation of Authority**

In accordance with Section 2-8.3 of the County Code related to identifying delegation of Board authority, there is no authority beyond that specified in the resolution, which includes authority for the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute this Supplemental Agreement.

## Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

There is no fiscal impact associated with this item.

## Track Record/Monitor

Rakeshpal S. Gill, DTPW Construction Manager 3, is responsible for the Project's implementation.

# **Background**

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The South Dade TransitWay is an existing 20-mile long corridor connecting South Dade to the Metrorail. The South Corridor Project is one of the Strategic Miami Area Rapid Transit (SMART) Corridors and will provide the County an opportunity to significantly improve access and mobility within this area of the County.

On October 4, 2019, a Notice to Professional Consultants was advertised under full and open competition for CEI services for the Project. On January 31, 2020, HNTB Corporation was found in compliance with the applicable FTA and Disadvantaged Business Enterprise requirements established for the solicitation. On February 2, 2021, the contract with HNTB was awarded with a not to exceed amount of \$21,185,737.85. On July 6, 2023, Supplemental Agreement No. 2 was approved under Resolution No. R-609-23 to extend the contract duration by 400 calendar days and to add additional funds in the amount of \$3,700,000.

This Supplemental Agreement 3 extends the contract time by 339 non-compensable calendar days – ending on August 30, 2025. In 2019, the design-build contract for construction of the South Corridor was advertised; it specified the design, programming, and installation of Econolite traffic signal controllers shall serve all intersections along the corridor. Subsequent to the award of the design-build contract and following an analysis period for the Advanced Traffic Management System (ATMS) Project, the County selected the Siemens 2070LX traffic controller as the only qualified modern traffic controller for use in Miami-Dade County. Accounting for the complex operations and maintenance of the South Corridor, the risk analysis showed that it would benefit the County to issue a Change Order to the contractor to program, install, and integrate the Siemens 2070LX traffic controllers along the corridor. Notably, an additional risk analysis was performed following the termination of Yunex Traffic (the ATMS Contractor) and no further change in the technology is recommended. The recommended additional 339 days to the CEI PSA are consistent with Change Oder No. 2 to the design-build contract with OHL Contractor Inc. for installation of the traffic controllers along the TransitWay and additional scope (e.g., resurfacing work). Change Order No. 2 is scheduled for approval by the Board in October 2024.

Additionally, approval of this extension allows HNTB to oversee the deployment of the fare collection system on the South Dade TransitWay, which was being considered under a separate procurement, but was ultimately included in the design-build contract to achieve consistency with contract documents and project schedule. As a result of the additional time being requested for the construction contract, as well as the expanded scope, the contract with HNTB Corporation for CEI services will need to be extended.

This extension will use funds already available in the contract; consequently, this item has no fiscal impact.

### **Due Diligence**

Pursuant to Resolution No. R-187-12, and in accordance with the Internal Services Department's Procurement Guidelines, DTPW staff exercised due diligence to determine

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Consultant responsibility for HNTB Corporation. The lists that were referenced included, but were not limited to: convicted vendors, debarred vendors, delinquent contractors, suspended vendors and federal excluded parties. There were no adverse findings relating to the Consultant's responsibility. There are nine evaluations on record for HNTB Corporation in the Capital Improvements Information System with an average rating of 3.7 out of a possible 4.0 points.
