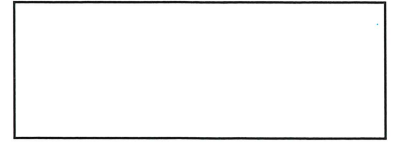

SUBJECT: Resolution codesignating portion of Northeast 151st Street between Northeast 21st Avenue and Harriet Tubman Highway as "Irv David Boulevard"

Section 2-1 Rule 9.02(f) of the Code requires the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) to conduct background research on any person, organization, place, or thing that is the subject of a naming, renaming, or codesignation item, or an item approving the codesignation of state or municipal roads and prepare a report detailing the findings of said research prior to the Commission meeting during which the item is scheduled to be considered.

Commission Auditor's Conclusion:

OCA completed the required background research on "Irvin David" and noted no adverse findings. OCA has determined no prior Board of County Commissioners (BCC) codesignations for "Irv David Boulevard." Also, as required by rule 9.02(f)(1), OCA verified that "Irvin David" is deceased.
