RESOLUTION NO. R-1174-21

RESOLUTION DECLARING DECEMBER 1, 2021 AND DECEMBER 1 FOR EACH YEAR THEREAFTER AS "WORLD AIDS DAY"

WHEREAS, Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome (AIDS) is a chronic, potentially lifethreatening condition caused by the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV); and

WHEREAS, National World AIDS Day was founded in 1988 and takes place on December 1 each year; and

WHEREAS, according to the United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), World AIDS Day was the first-ever global health day; and

WHEREAS, HIV continues to be a major global public health issue, having claimed more than 33 million lives to date; and

WHEREAS, according to the World Health Organization, by the end of 2019, approximately 38 million people were living with HIV, and only approximately 81 percent of these individuals knew their status; and

WHEREAS, increased HIV vulnerability is often associated with social factors, which increase exposure to risk situations and create barriers to accessing effective, quality, and affordable HIV prevention, testing, and treatment options; and

WHEREAS, while there is no cure or vaccine available to treat and protect all people currently living with or at risk for HIV infection, effective prevention interventions are available which can control the virus and help prevent onward transmission to other people; and

WHEREAS, World AIDS Day is an opportunity for people worldwide to unite in the fight against HIV, to show support for people living with HIV, and to commemorate those who have died from an AIDS-related illness; and

WHEREAS, highlighting methods and resources to reduce HIV stigma and promote prevention, testing, and treatment options for HIV and AIDS is imperative to protect Miami-Dade County residents and people around the world,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board declares December 1, 2021, and December 1 for each year thereafter, as "World AIDS Day."

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator René García and the Co-Sponsor is Commissioner Sally A. Heyman. It was offered by Commissioner Sally A. Heyman , who moved its adoption.
