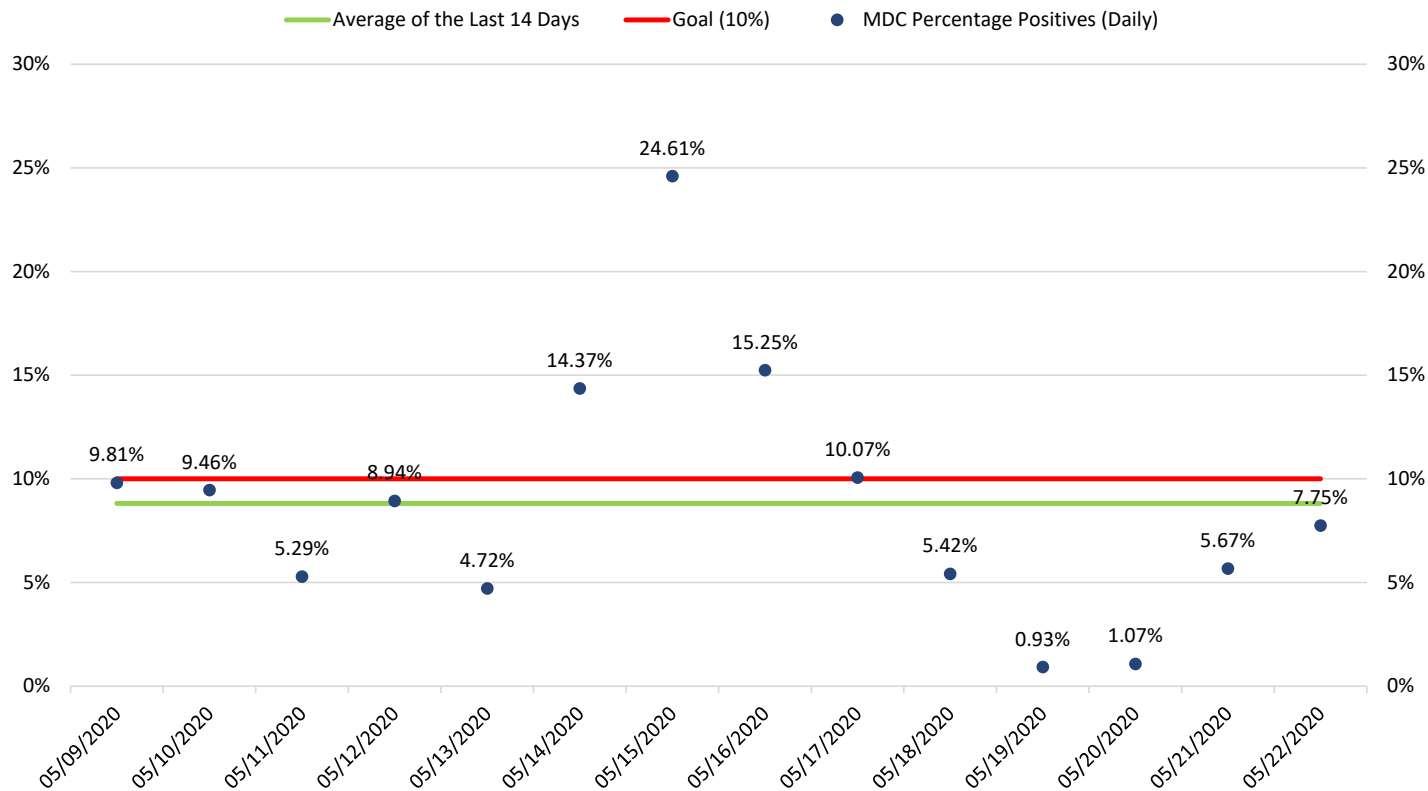

Daily Positive Cases out of Total Tests

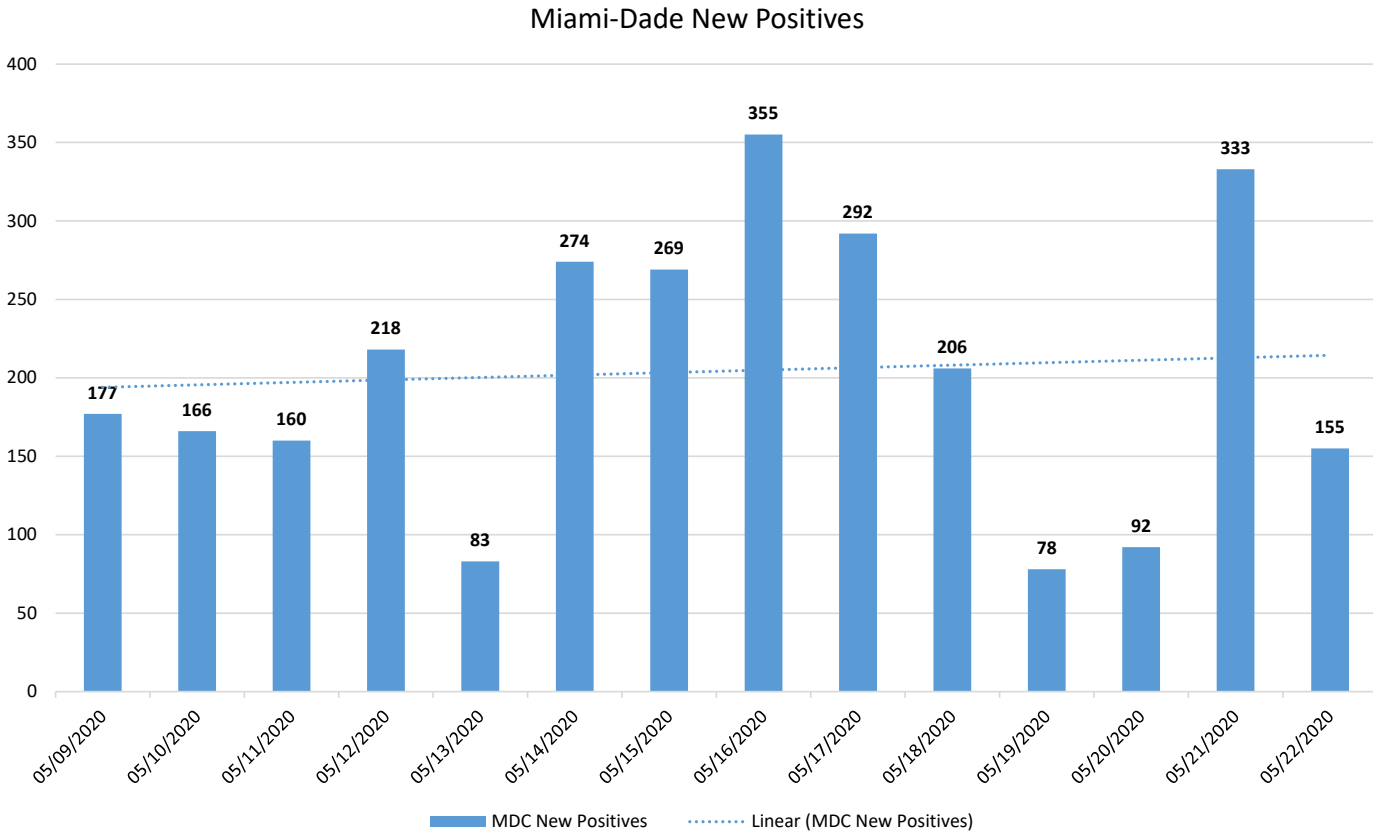
Daily Positive Cases out of Total Tests

New Positive Cases



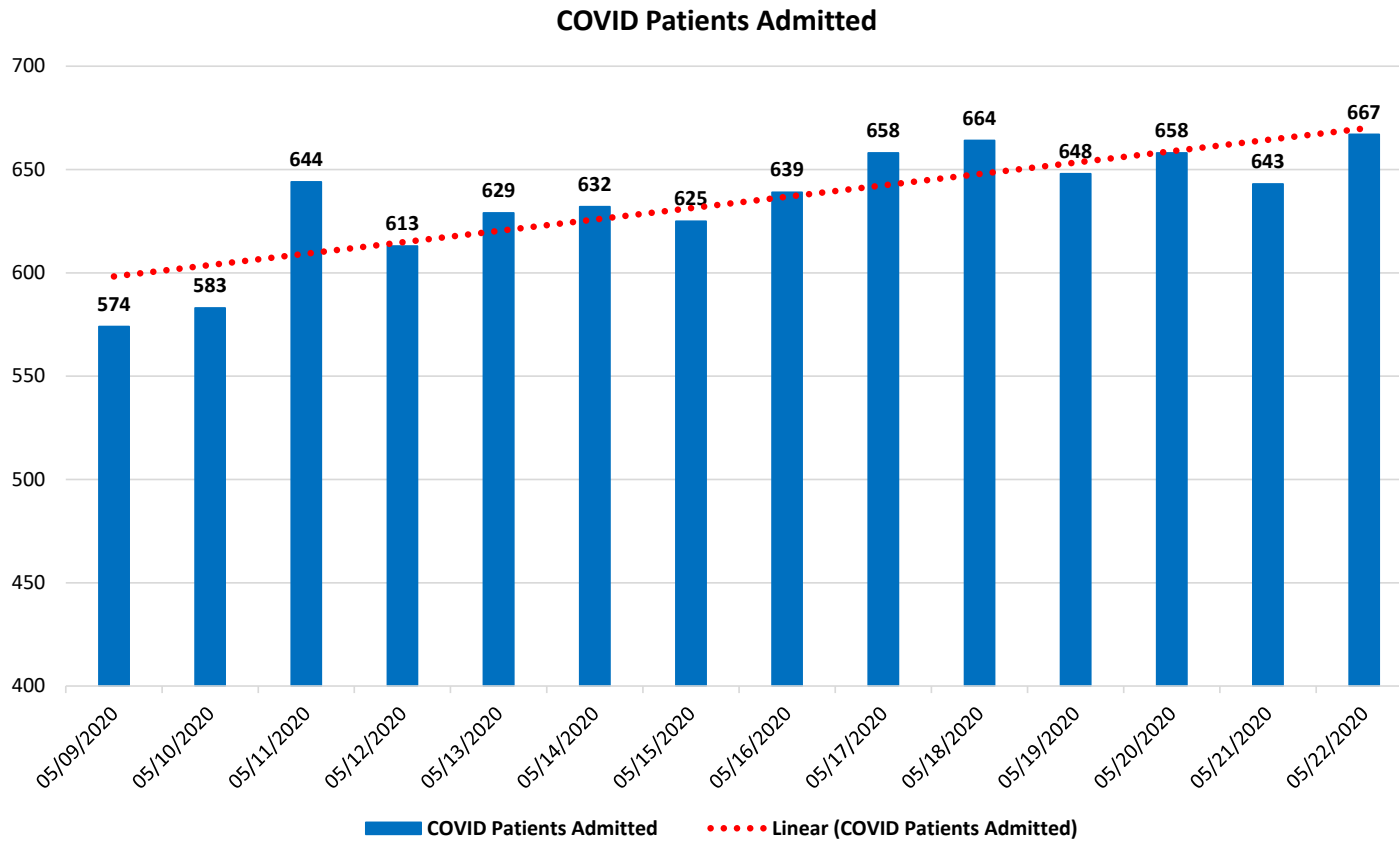

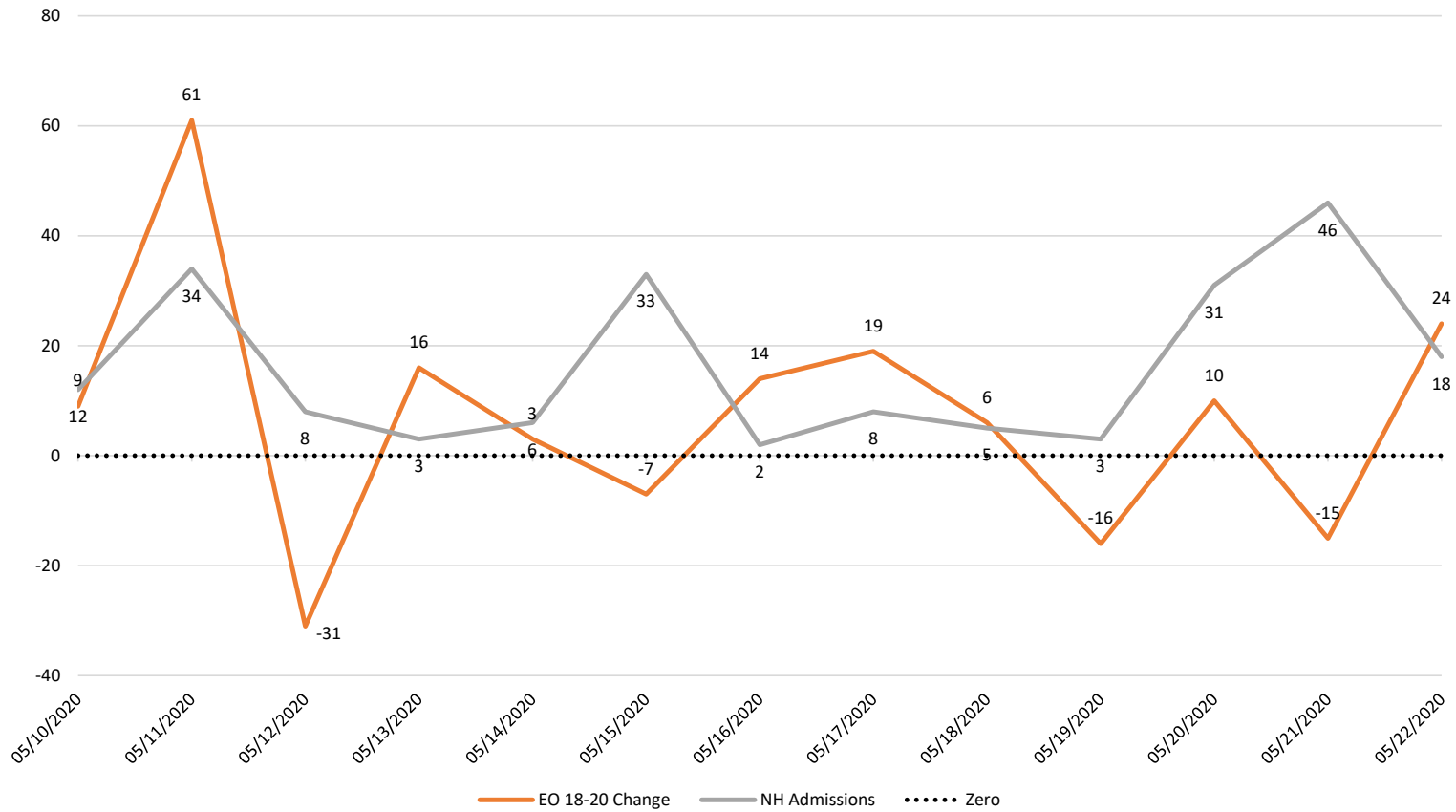
COVID-19 Admitted Patients

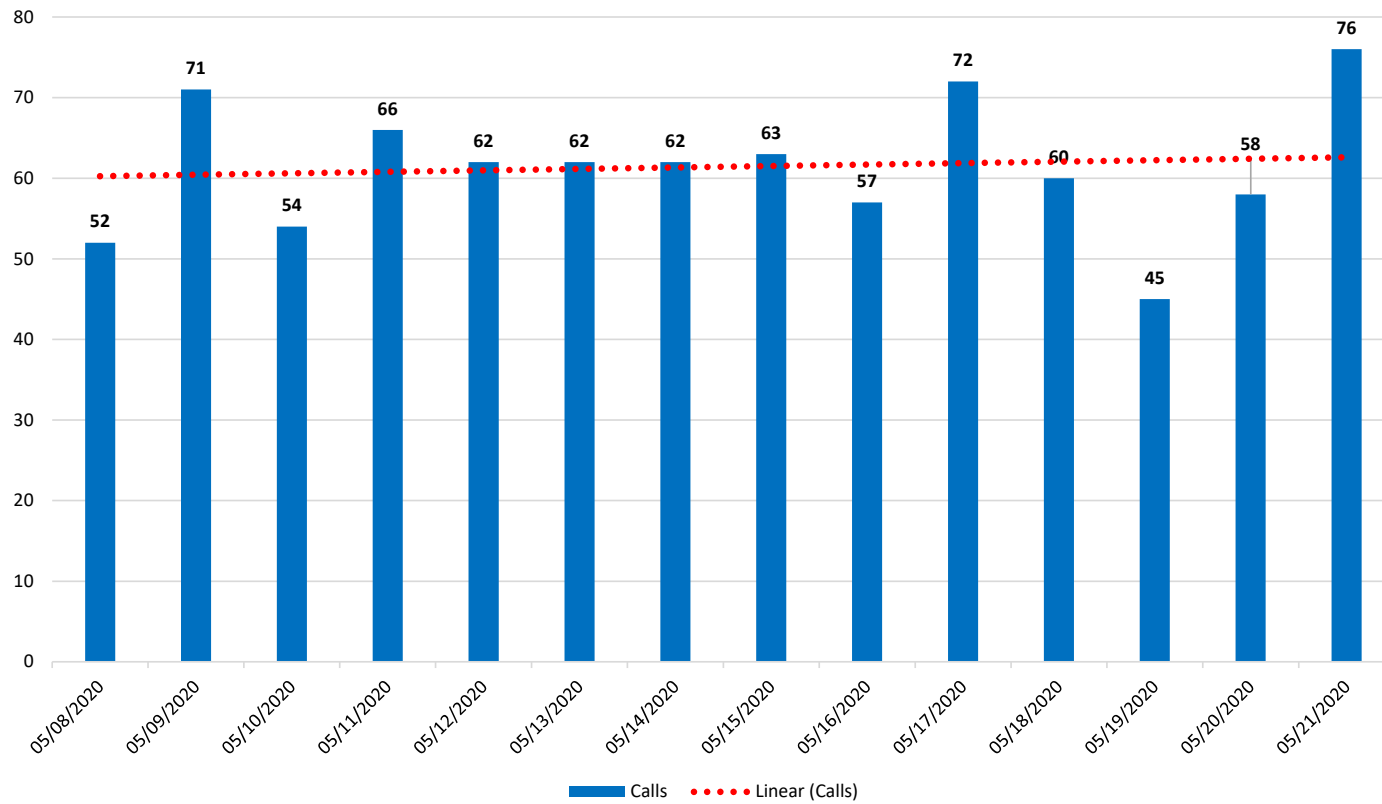

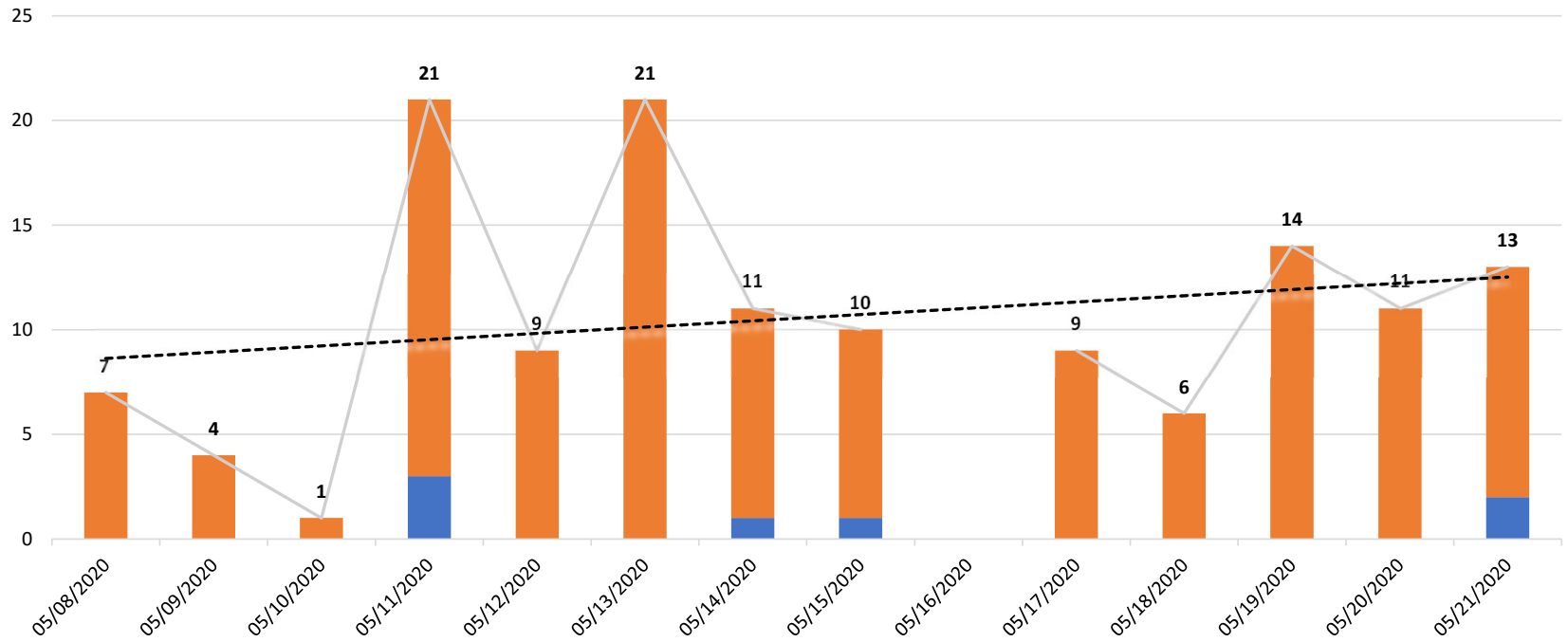
MDFR Suspected COVID-19 Calls
