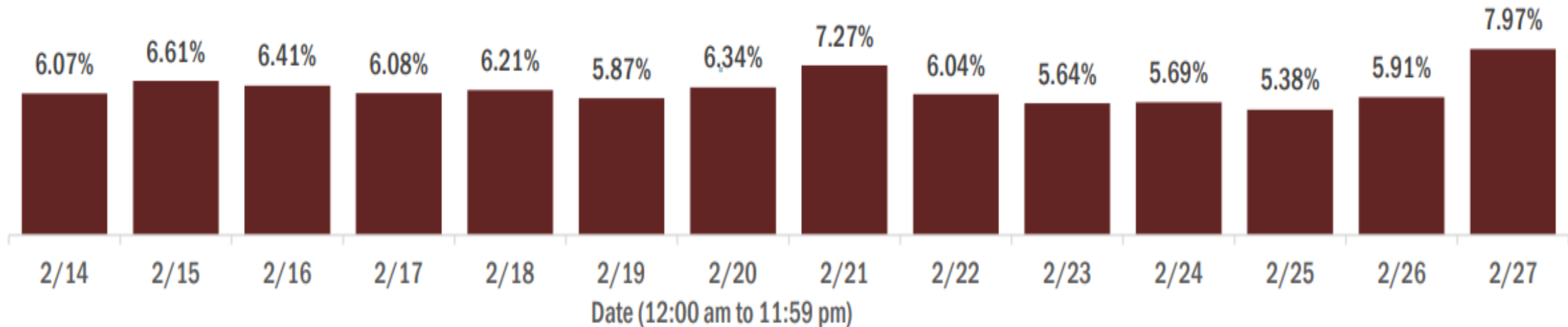

Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents

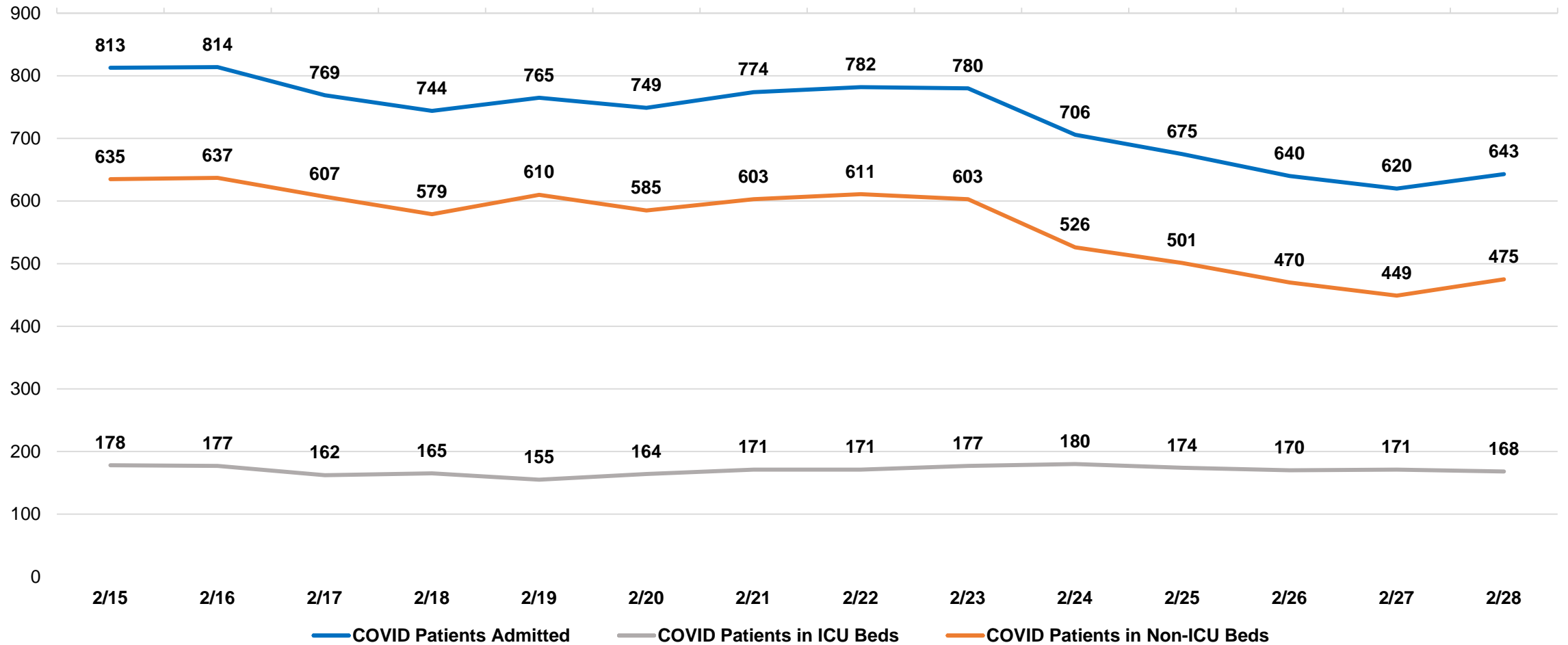

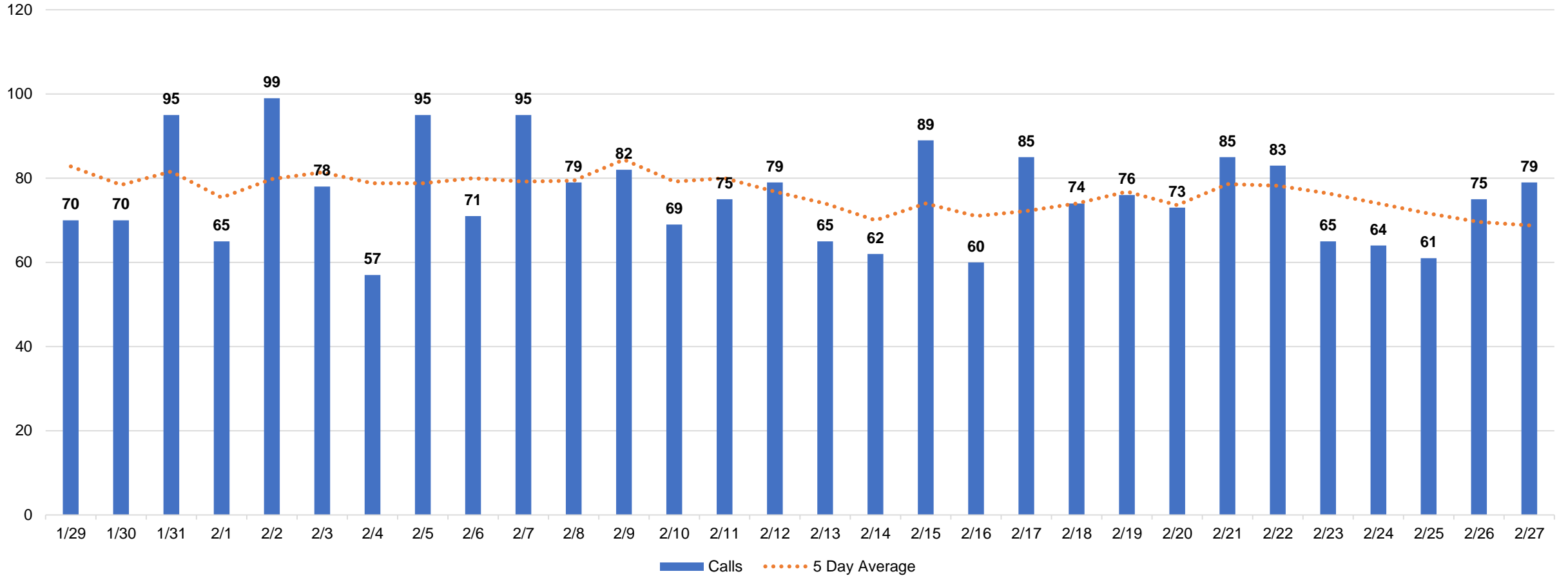

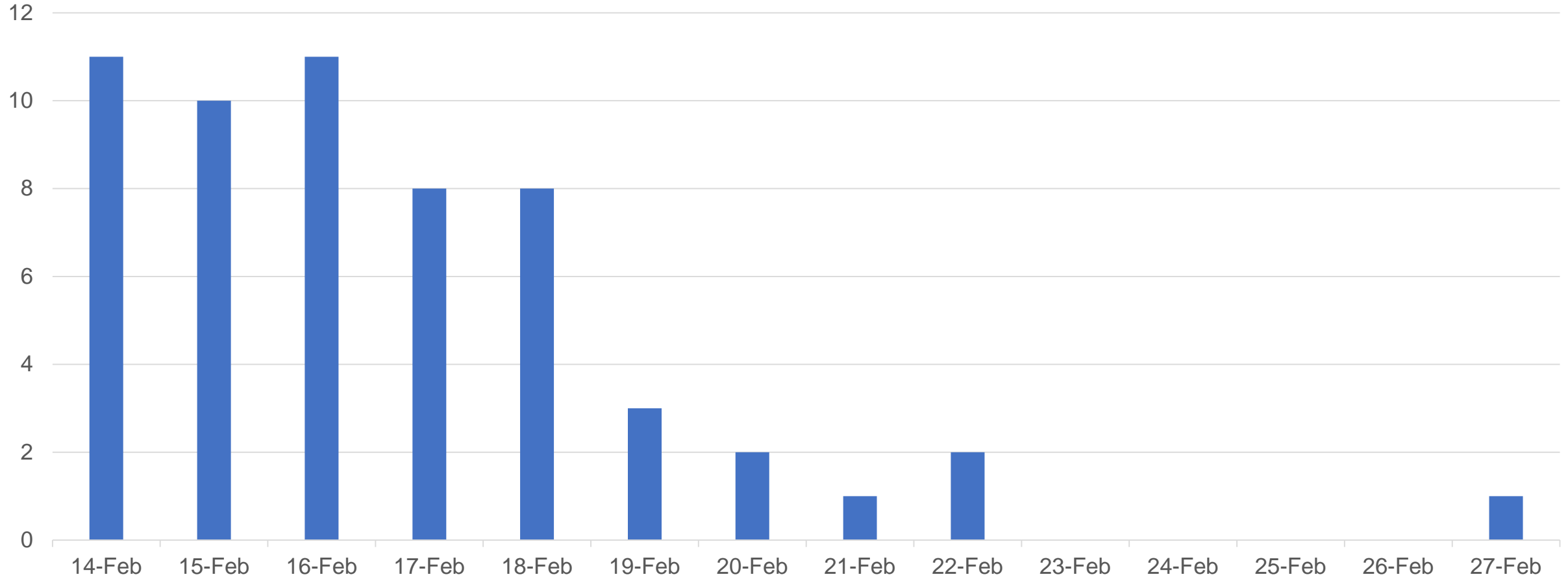
Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Calls

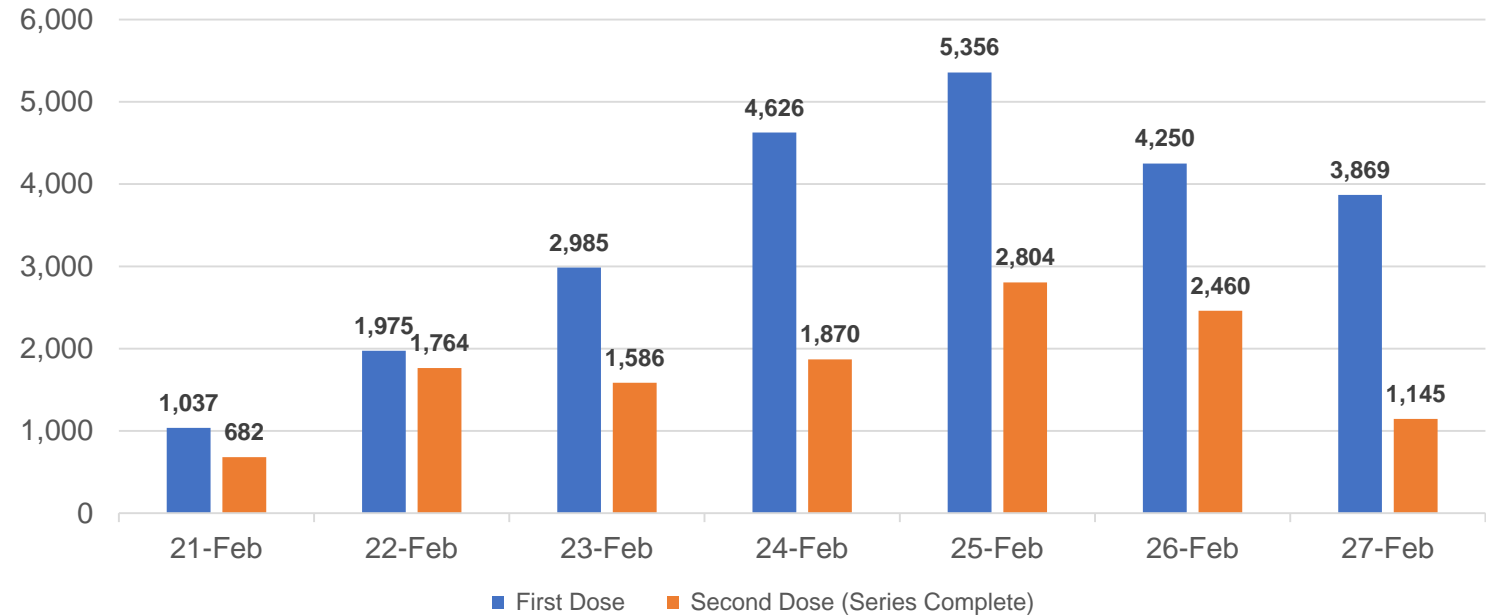

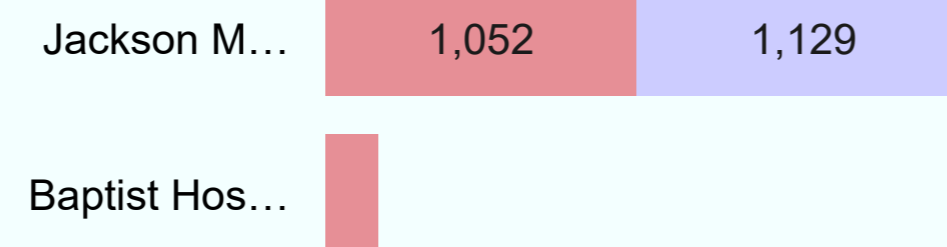

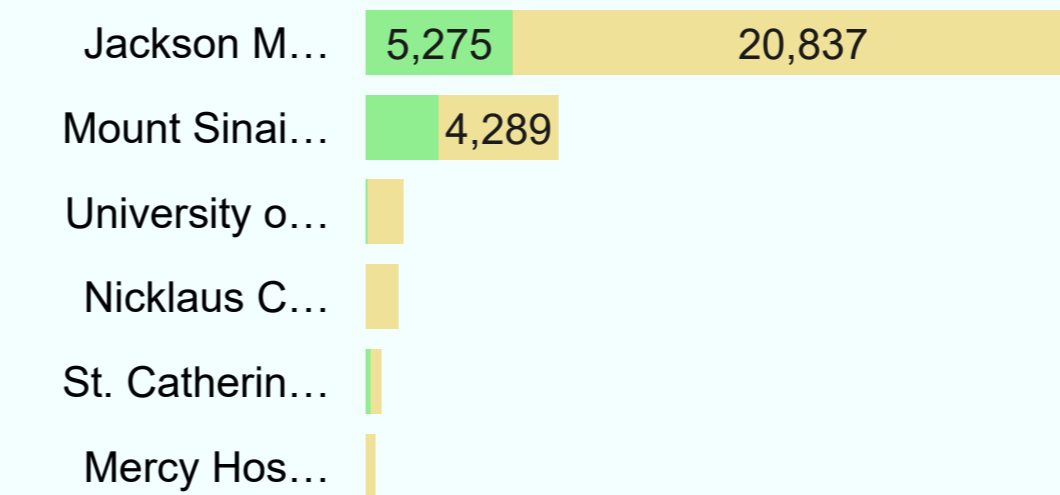

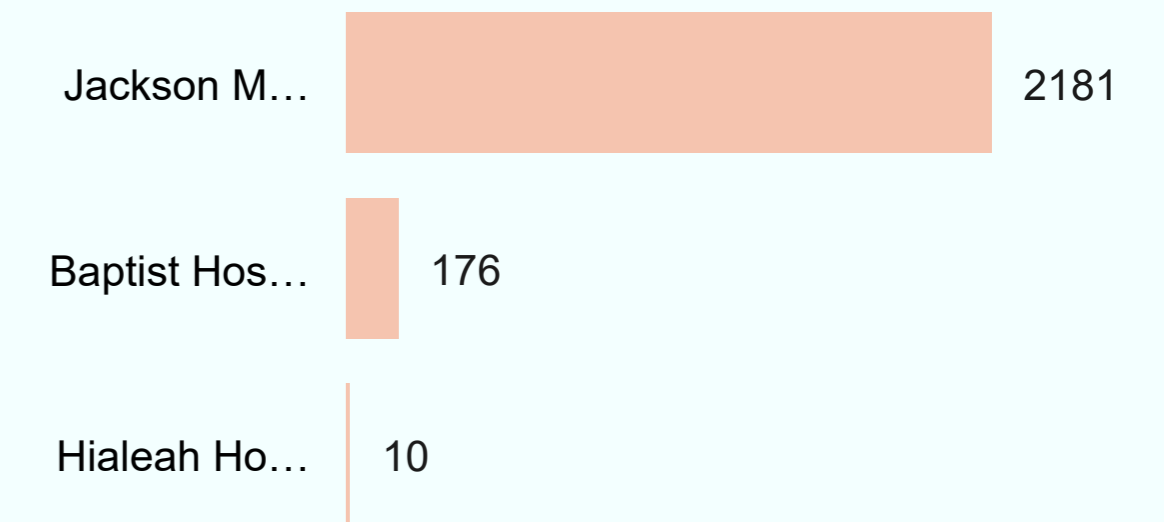


Vaccines On Hand by Hospital

● First Dose ● Second Dose



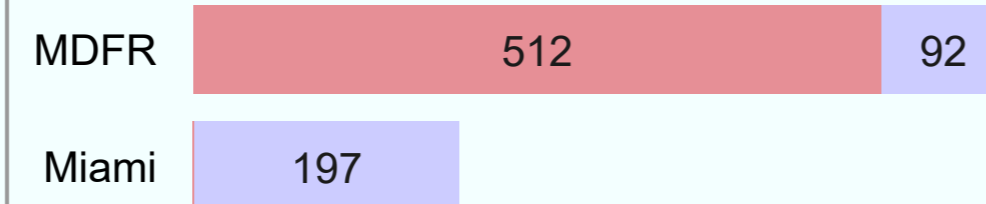

New Vaccines Received by City/County

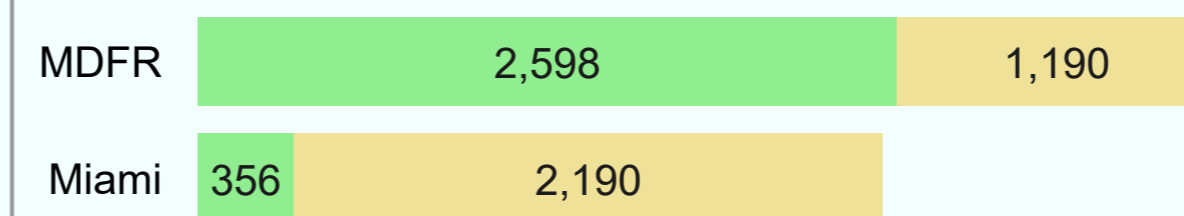
Vaccines Administered by City/County

● First Dose ● Second Dose

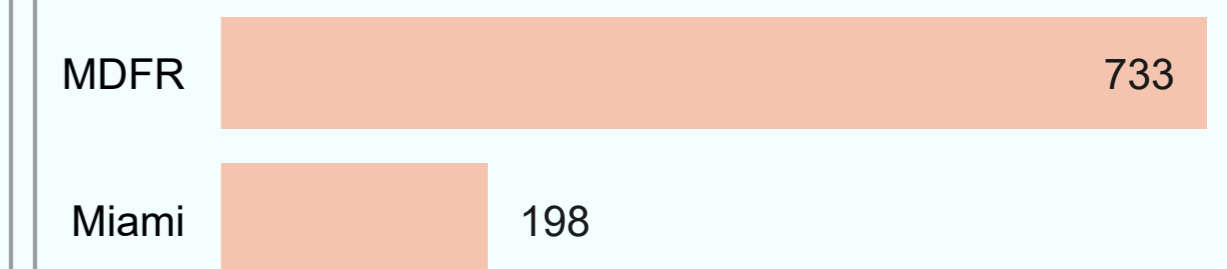


Vaccines On Hand by City/County

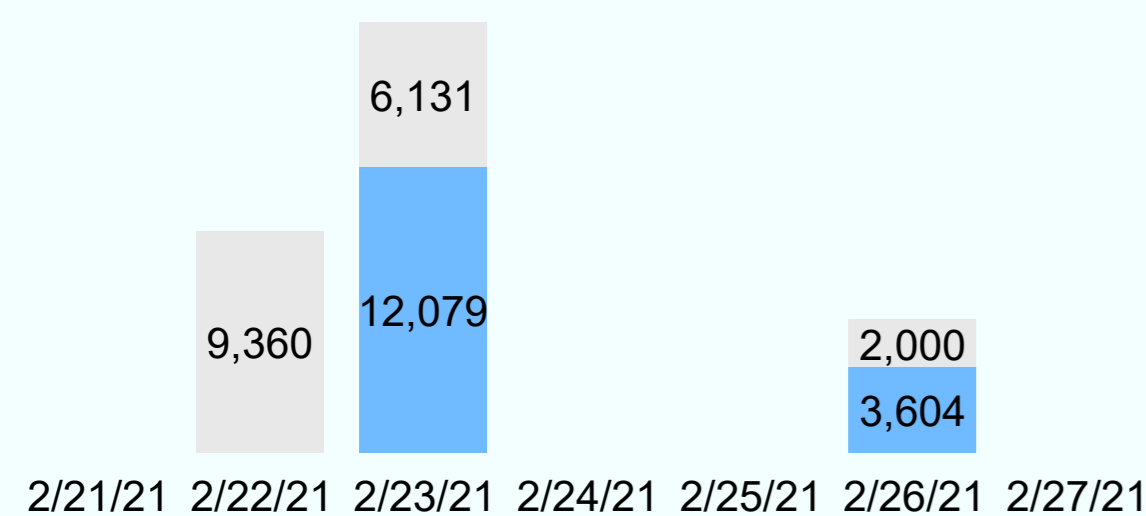

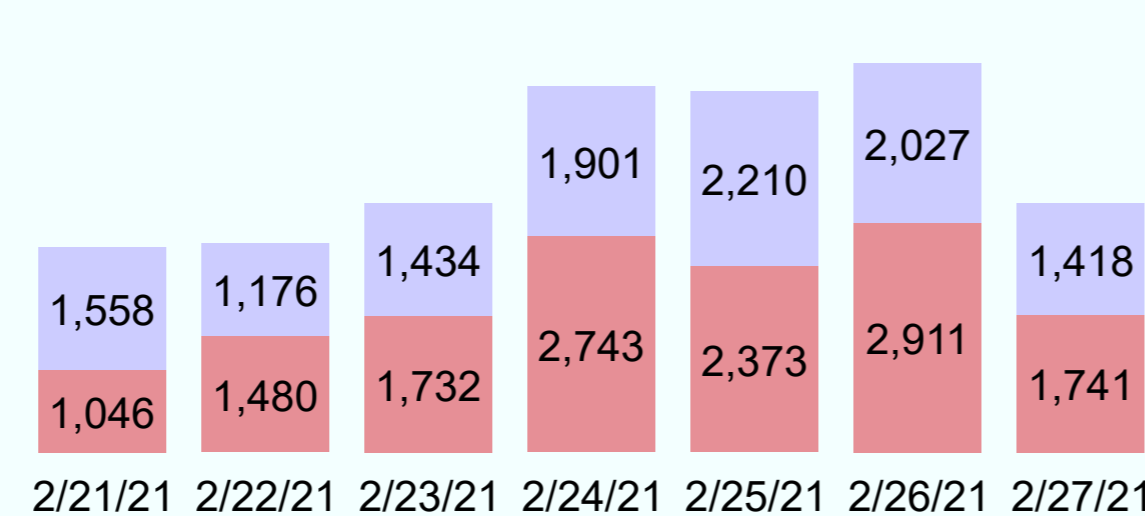
New Vaccines Received by Date

● First Dose ● Second Dose



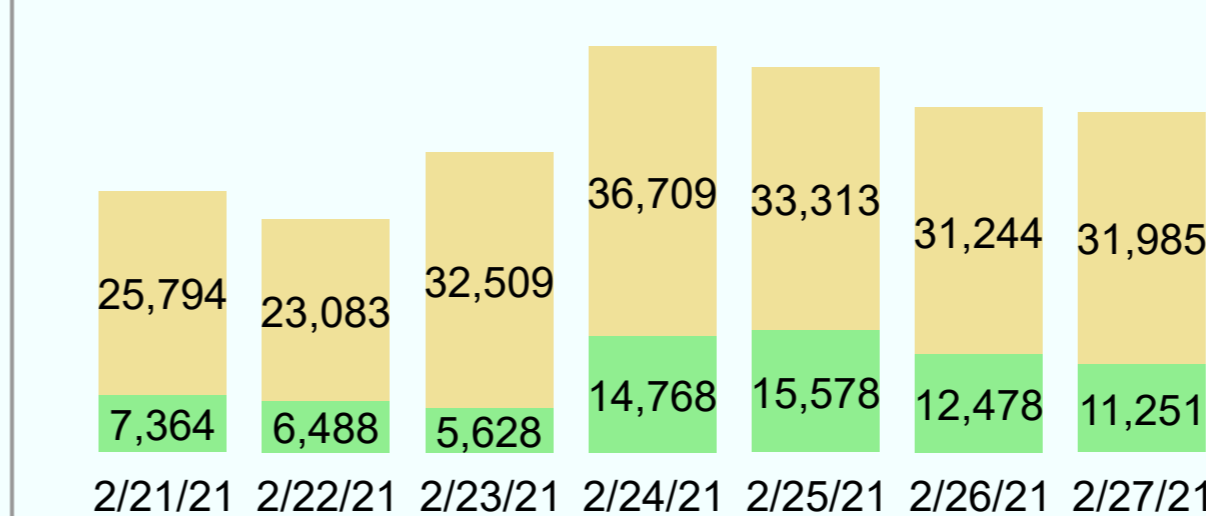
Vaccines Administered by Date
