

## FILMING ON MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PROPERTY

---

### SUMMARY

No person shall film on a publicly-owned site, facility or right-of-way within unincorporated Miami-Dade County without first obtaining a Film/Photo permit from the Office of Film and Entertainment in the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources. Exceptions are allowed for individuals filming for private use only and for the news media covering breaking news. Student permits are issued separately students and faculty filming for educational purposes.

### PROCEDURE

1. Film, television and still photo productions must apply for a Film/Photo permit from the Office of Film and Entertainment for access to Miami-Dade County facilities and/or County-owned rights-of-way, and the same applies to productions that occur in municipalities that have entered into film permitting interlocal agreements with Miami-Dade County. Permit applications and a list of municipalities for which Miami-Dade County provides these services are available on-line at [www.filmiami.org](http://www.filmiami.org).
2. The Office of Film and Entertainment shall facilitate and coordinate the use of publicly-owned sites for film, television, and still photography productions with County agencies, Departments, and any municipality for which an interlocal agreement exists.
3. Film/Photo Permits shall be granted unless the proposed production unduly impedes governmental business or public access, conflicts with previously scheduled activities, imperils public safety, or violates provisions of applicable agreements.
4. Film/Photo permit applicants shall provide insurance indemnification for Miami-Dade County covering the County against all claims arising from the production.
5. Applicants shall pay all applicable fees, including any direct expenses incurred by Miami-Dade County on behalf of the production.
