- Is it a post-mortem body disposal or a drowning?
- Nonfatal aquatic abuse & torture in intimate partner and domestic violence
- What to photo and document on the body & scene
- Bathtub, bucket, toilet, pool, & openwater incidents.
- 12 main reasons homicides are misdiagnosed as aquatic accidents or suicides
- Indications of homicidal drowning & land homicides staged as aquatic accidents or suicides.
- Was it not there, or did the dive team miss it?- How can you tell the difference
- What happens to submerged bodies and evidence?
- Submerged evidence recovery / processing (DNA, weapons, latents)
- Preservation of possible water crime scene
- Autoerotic aquatic asphyxia and Aquatic Sexual Sadism
