Public Housing and Community Development

The Public Housing and Community Development Department (PHCD) administers federal funding for all of the County's housing and community development programs, including public housing, rental housing, affordable housing, rehabilitation and revitalization. These programs have been developed to provide decent and sanitary affordable housing opportunities to the income (PHCD) groups defined by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) as extremely low, very low, low income families Department: and individuals. PHCD's primary federally subsidized housing programs are the Public Housing Program and the Section 8 Housing Public Choice Voucher Program. The performance of these programs are monitored by HUD. PHCD provides assistance and programs that expand economic opportunity and community development, including affordable housing development, economic development, Community historical preservation, housing rehabilitation, capital improvements to public facilities and public services. These programs are funded by the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Documentary Stamp Surtax Program (Surtax), State Housing Initiatives Partnership Program (SHIP), and Home Investment Partnership Program (HOME).
