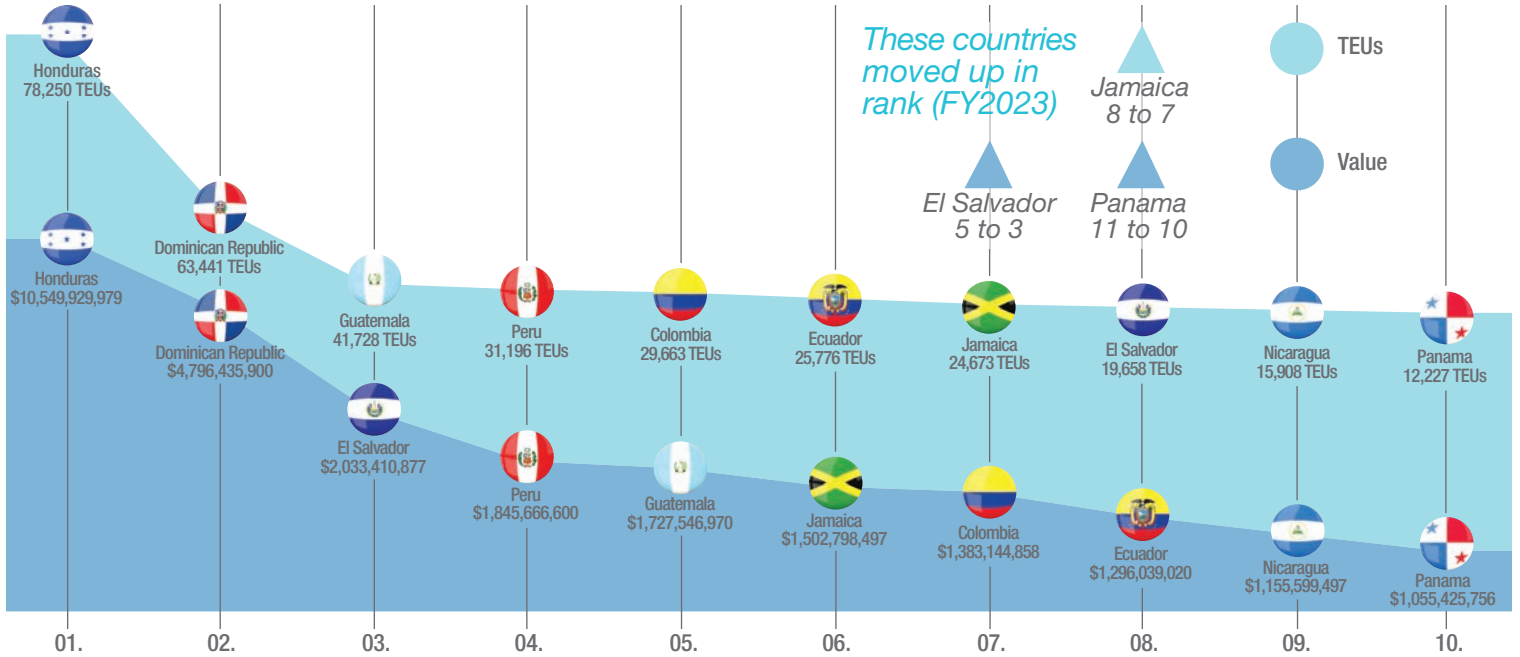

# Top 10 Trade Partners: Overall

Latin America and The Caribbean represents 48% of all trade with PortMiami – 509,210 TEUs with a total value of \$31.6 Billion (FY 2023.) Its top ten trade partners represent 349,234 TEUs with a total value of \$28.1 Billion (FY 2023.)

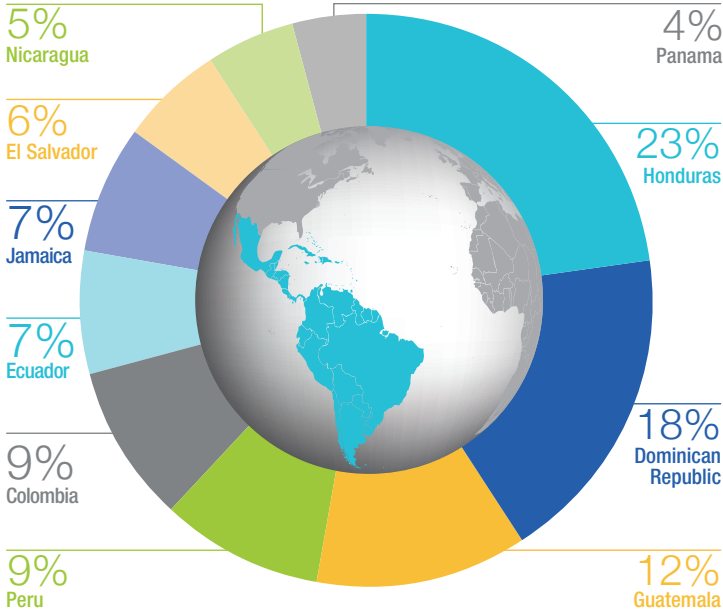

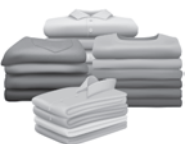

## Fast Facts

These four commodities represent 240,447 TEUs and a value of \$16 Billion for PortMiami.

### Fruits & Vegetables

PortMiami is a vital gateway for perishables from the region. It is the Port's number one overall commodity in TEUs and fourth in Value.



### Apparel & Textiles

Top trading partners El Salvador, Honduras, Colombia and Guatemala move t-shirts, under garments and towels in and out of the US through PortMiami.

### Machinery

Machinery imports/exports are driven by increasing construction projects. This makes machinery a critical commodity for PortMiami.



### Furniture

Furniture imports remain a strong commodity for PortMiami. It is driven by Florida's growing population as well as huge manufacturing increases in the region.

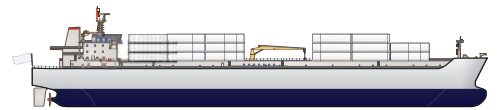
