Domestic violence victims and their dependents can get help with counseling, early intervention services, protection and empowerment at one of:

- Four Domestic Violence Certified Centers (Shelters)
- Two transitional housing programs
- One Coordinated Victims Assistance Center

Non-residential and residential assistance is available





Non-Residential Programs

CAHSD non-residential programs offer assistance and coordinated services with community partners and other agencies.

Coordinated Victims Assistance Center (CVAC)

The CVAC is a one-stop, non-residential center for victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, dating violence and human trafficking. The CVAC provides on-site coordinated services with community partners, faith-based organizations, universities, nonprofit agencies and other governmental agencies.

Call or visit the Coordinate Victims Assistance office. An assessment will be given to determine eligibility of available services, which include:

- Counseling information and referral
- Safe shelter
- Transportation
- Emergency financial assistance
- Emergency food and clothing
- Advocacy support
- Individual treatment and family group counseling

Domestic Violence Outreach Unit (DVOU) / Court Advocacy Project (CAP)

The DVOU/CAP is a court based program that offers injunctions for protection assistance and representation, advocacy and support, emergency financial assistance, crisis counseling and other services.

Human Trafficking Unit (HTU)

The HTU provides coordinated services to victims of human trafficking.

Injunction for Protection (IFP) Project

The IFP Project offers consultation and/or legal representation to victims of domestic violence, sexual violence, dating violence and stalking in the process of seeking injunctive relief.

Training and Educational Committee (TEC)

The TEC offers educational presentations and training sessions throughout Miami Dade County in three languages (Spanish, Creole and English)

Volunteer Program

The Volunteer Program seeks the involvement of individuals who are committed to assisting victims of crime through the VPID.

Residential Programs

CAHSD residential programs offer both emergency shelter and transitional housing options for victims and their dependents, and provide a variety of support services, including:

- Crisis counseling
- Advocacy and support
- Relocation assistance
- Emergency financial assistance
- Referrals
- Transportation
- And more

Inn Transition Program

Inn Transition provides temporary transitional housing to female victims of domestic violence. Eligible clients must be 18 years or older, have at least one dependent and a source of income.

Safespace Shelter

Safespace is a temporary shelter for victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and human trafficking.

Victim Housing Assistance Program (VHAP)

The Victim Housing Assistance Program (VHAP) is a residential program that provides a transitional housing opportunity to victims of domestic violence and their dependents.
