Six convenient express routes to serve your commuting needs:

— Ft. Lauderdale to Downtown Miami

- Nonstop service every 15 minutes during weekday rush hours between the Fort Lauderdale Tri-Rail Station located at Broward Boulevard & I-95 and downtown Miami.
- Southbound buses depart from 5:45 until 8:45 a.m. and from 4:42 until 5:57 p.m. Northbound buses depart from 6:17 until 7:58 a.m. and from 3:43 until 6:53 p.m.

— Hollywood to Downtown Miami

- Nonstop service every 15 minutes during weekday rush hours between the Sheridan Street Tri-Rail Station located at Sheridan Street & I-95 and downtown Miami.
- Southbound buses depart from 5:45 until 8:45 a.m. and from 4:42 until 5:53 p.m. Northbound buses depart from 6:28 until 7:58 a.m. and from 4:18 until 7:18 p.m.

— Pembroke Pines to Downtown Miami

- Service every 30 minutes during weekday rush hours, with stops at University Drive, U.S. 441, the Hollywood Tri-Rail Station and the Golden Glades Park & Ride lot.
- Southbound buses depart from C.B. Smith Park located at Pines Boulevard & Flamingo Road from 5:45 until 8:45 a.m. and from 4 until 6 p.m. Northbound buses depart from the Miami-Dade Government Center from 6 until 8 a.m. and from 3:45 until 6:45 p.m.

— Golden Glades to Downtown Miami

— P.M. Alignment in Downtown Miami

- Nonstop service every 5 to 15 minutes during weekday rush hours to downtown Miami and Brickell Financial District, serving all local bus stops in downtown and Brickell.
- Southbound buses depart from 5:27 until 9:30 a.m and from 2:23 until 6:11 p.m. Northbound buses depart from approximately 6 until 10 a.m. and from approximately 3 until 7:30 p.m. from downtown Miami.

— Golden Glades to Miami's Civic Center

- Nonstop service approximately every 15 minutes during weekday rush hours to Miami's Civic Center/Health District, serving all local bus stops south of NW 20th Street.
- Southbound buses depart from 5:58 a.m. until 8:15 a.m. and from 4:21 until 4:34 p.m. Northbound buses depart from Veterans Hospital from 6:18 until 8:18 a.m. and from 3:30 to 6:08 p.m.

— Golden Glades to Earlington Heights Metrorail Station and Doral

- Southbound bus departs at 6:43 a.m. Northbound bus departs at 5:08 p.m. from Doral. Serves all local bus stops west of LeJeune Road.
