### Wastewater Line Replacement


The Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) has embarked on a Capital Improvement Program to provide necessary upgrades to the water and sewer infrastructure to continue providing high quality services, protecting public health, and the environment. One of these projects is a new wastewater pipeline in your neighborhood. This project is part of the Consent Decree Program which requires several operational and maintenance improvements to Miami-Dade's wastewater system.

On April 9, 2014, the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida authorized a Consent Decree between Miami-Dade County, the United States of America, the State of Florida, and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, for improvements to the County's wastewater collection system. The rehabilitation of wastewater lines for Consent Decree project 4.10 (1) is part of this program.

#### PROJECT INFORMATION / SCHEDULE

Construction of the new pipeline is expected to begin in January 2017 and expected to be completed in seven months. Construction work will take place during the week from sunrise to sunset. The contractor will take additional steps to minimize impacts, but you may experience some noise and intermittent traffic inconvenience due to lane and road closures or detours. At the conclusion of the project, the roadway areas impacted by the construction will be restored. We thank you for your continued support.

# Project at a Glance

Project Number 4.10 (1)

- Rehabilitation of approximately 2,555 linear feet of existing 48-inch wastewater line along the Biscayne Canal between NW 32 Avenue and NW 37 Avenue.
- Rehabilitation of an existing 48-inch valve just west of NW 37 Avenue and Biscayne Canal.
- Replacement of 100 linear feet of 48-inch wastewater line along NW 32 Avenue between NW 156 Street and Biscayne
- Connect new 48-inch wastewater line connecting to the existing 72-inch line on NW 156 Street and NW 32 Avenue.
- The upgrade will not affect the water or the wastewater services in your area.
- There may be temporary lane closures or detours. Access to your property will always be granted.
- The areas surrounding the construction will be restored at the conclusion of the project.
